



## NIH Awards to Medical School Departments Diagnostic Radiology in Fiscal Year 2016

The total amount of NIH dollars going to Contact PIs having primary appointments in Diagnostic Radiology Departments has decreased very slightly in FY 2016 ( 1.49% ) as compared to FY 2015 (\$426,629,827 vs \$433,070,490). As in previous reports, the total dollars listed (direct + indirect) do not include the NIH Contracts awarded to PIs in Diagnostic Radiology Departments. Traditionally, these are about 2% of total dollars awarded. In order to avoid counting a single award many times, multiple principal investigators (MPIs) are counted for the Department tally only if the Contact PI is in another Department.
