Washington, DC – May 22, 2018 – The Academy for Radiology & Biomedical Imaging Research is pleased to announce that 42 researchers have been selected to receive the Academy's 2018 ***Distinguished Investigator Award***. This prestigious honor recognizes individuals for their accomplishments in the field of medical imaging.

Each of the honorees has met the following criteria:

- ❖ Primary professional appointment in an academic Department of Radiology;
- ❖ Recipient of a MD, DO, and/or PhD degree;
- ❖ Academic rank of at least Associate Professor or its equivalent;
- ❖ Significant research contributions;
- ❖ Sustained productivity, including at least 25 peer-reviewed scientific research publications in which the awardee is the first author or senior author; and
- ❖ Demonstrated accomplishment as an independent investigator with a substantial ongoing research program, including at least 6 cumulative years of funding as the Principal Investigator of a major competitive extramural research grant.

All recipients of this award will be inducted into the Academy's Council of ***Distinguished Investigators*** during a ceremony that will be held in November at the Radiological Society of North America's annual meeting.
