As in previous reports, the total dollars listed (direct + indirect) do not include the NIH Contracts awarded to PIs in Diagnostic Radiology Departments. Traditionally, these are about 2-3 % of total dollars awarded.

In order to avoid counting a single award many times, multiple principal investigators (MPIs) are counted for the Department tally only if the Contact PI is in another Department.

Since so many departments participate in ECOG/ACRIN grants through subcontracts, etc no single department is given credit for the total award. The FY 2014 ECOG/ACRIN award of \$18,660,055. is listed as a separate entity at the bottom of the ranking and included in the Grand Total.

Surprisingly the total amount of NIH dollars going to Contact PIs having primary appointments in Diagnostic Radiology Departments went up in FY 2014 by 10.3% as compared to FY 2013 ( \$409,492,108 vs \$362,641,943 ) This is a remarkable accomplishment since almost all other disciplines have gone down in view of the budget problems at the NIH. .  
As in previous years, there remains a large imbalance in how the dollars are distributed. Of the Institutions on our list, the top 7 account for 50% of the funds and top 20 for 80%.  
Hopefully next year we will again see growth in our NIH funded research programs.
