The Academy/CIBR was successful in submitting the following report language in the House and Senate:

**Senate CJS Language:**

Interagency Working Group on Medical Imaging.-The Committee is pleased that OSTP has convened the Interagency Working Group on Medical Imaging as directed in this Committee's fiscal year 2015 report, Senate Report 113-181. Basic, use-inspired.

Discoveries in core technologies like medical imaging can spur the type of technology-driven jobs and start up activity that will result in sustainable economic growth and drive the Nation's economy in the coming century. OSTP is directed to provide a report with an update on the Working Group's activities and recommendations not later than 180 days after the enactment of this act.

**Language in Senate bill:**

"Imaging.-The Committee notes that imaging research occurs in multiple ICs throughout the NIH and is an integral component of the BRAIN Initiative. The Committee requests NIH provide an overview of imaging research throughout all NIH activities, including collaborations with other HHS and non-HHS agencies. The Committee requests this information be included in the fiscal year."
