Since 2011, Dr. Coley has been the Frederic N. Silverman Chair of Pediatric Radiology and Radiologist-in-Chief at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, and Professor of Radiology and Pediatrics at the University of Cincinnati College of Medicine. In his current role, Dr. Coley oversees one of the premier clinical, research, and teaching pediatric imaging departments, in one of the top academic pediatric institutions in the world. A central goal of the Department of Radiology and Cincinnati Children's is to continue to develop and invest in the infrastructure and discovery that allows us to improve pediatric health. The development and engagement of the faculty, staff, and trainees are a priority, ensuring that the resources and culture within the Department of Radiology and at Cincinnati Children's allow everyone to achieve their professional goals.

Brian completed his undergraduate education at Yale University, and then completed most of his medical training at the University of California, San Diego, before completing a pediatric radiology fellowship at Cincinnati Children's. He is the past president of the Society for Pediatric Radiology, the current president of the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine, and a Fellow in the American College of Radiology and other societies. Brian is the Editor-in-Chief of *Caffey's Pediatric Diagnostic Imaging*, is the author of numerous research papers and book chapters, and has spoken widely at national and international meetings.
