

F. Edward Boas, MD, PhD

Dr. Boas is an Interventional Radiologist at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center. He has developed a new type of local immunotherapy, which involves delivering powerful immune stimulants directly into liver metastases, in order to induce a stronger anti-tumor immune response, while avoiding collateral damage to normal cells.



Joe Cavallo, MD, MBA

Dr. Cavallo is an Assistant Professor of Radiology and Biomedical Imaging at the Yale School of Medicine. His company Illumion is removing the Black Box from Artificial Intelligence in Radiology. With explainability software that can interrogate deep neural networks, Illumion can provide the "why" behind complex diagnostic decisions like cancer.



Harrison Kim, MBA, PhD

Dr. Kim is an Associate Professor in the Department of Radiology at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB). He and his team have developed a point-of-care portable perfusion phantom (P4) for standardized and accurate quantification of perfusion MRI. Dr. Kim believes their device could markedly increase the use of perfusion MRI across the globe.
